# SWEFLs

- ◆ A SWEFL is a collegiate member with no fewer than 2 years left of a current degree program (freshman or sophomore for undergrad or 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> year grad student pursuing a PhD) who shows outstanding potential for future leadership in SWE.
- ◆ SWEFLs are invited to take part in the Collegiate Leadership Institute (CLI) held as part of the Annual Conference.
- ◆ Participate in a SWEFL mentoring program.
- ◆ Nomination process occurs in April .
